

#### **Inter-Agency Coordination to Oversee Organic Imports**



- Launched Organic Import Certificate in Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Import System (ACE) (April 2020)
- NOP Staff in CBP Commercial Targeting and Analysis Center
- Completing Trademark Process for USDA Organic Seal
- New Data Technology Projects
  - Import Certificate Generator
  - Data Visualization
  - Automation of Data Checks to Align Certificates and CBP Data

#### **Recent Enforcement Successes: Import Oversight**



#### **Uncertified Imports from India**

- CBP data on imports used to learn about feed imports from India.
- We compared data with business records required under USDA organic regulations.
- Analysis led to the identification of two exporters shipping to U.S. without organic certification
- Led to large civil penalty and increased monitoring data from importer.

#### **Illegally Labeled Olive Oil**

- Suspended organic operation continued to ship olive oil labeled as organic to U.S.
- CBP processes and authorities used to deny entry into U.S.
- Involved collaboration of CBP, Ports, and USDA

#### **Electronic Organic Import Certificates**



- New electronic oversight tool and process for USDA National Organic Program
- Responds to increasing complexity and length of organic supply chains
- Supports organic integrity by combatting fraud and increasing the traceability of organic products
- Supports organic enforcement to protect the USDA organic seal

Electronic organic import certificates will provide critical organic import data, improving oversight of organic imports



#### **Lacey Act Declaration**

Declarations must include:

- Importer information
- Scientific names of plants
- Country of harvest
- Quantity of plant material

Everything is driven by HTS (Harmonized Tariff Schedule) codes

According to the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995, an agency may not conduct or sponsor, and a person is not required to respond to, a collection of information unless it displays a valid OMB control number. The valid CMB control number for this information collection is 0579-0340. The time required to complete this information collection is estimated to average 0.5 hours per response, including the time for previewing instructions, searching existing data sources, gathering and maintaining the data needing, and completing may relevant previewing the collection.



#### **Phase Six Products**

#### Chapter 4415

- Does <u>not</u> include pallets and crates that are carrying products in commerce.
- Does <u>not</u> include used, repaired, recycled or reclaimed products.
- Only new products, making formal entry, will require a declaration

All products in the tariff codes listed in Phase Six require a declaration as of October 1, 2021.



#### Current Extended Pilot Phase

- CERT and PROD environments are Open to all ACE Filers at all FWS authorized ports
- FWS HTS Flags enforced with a "warning" severity

SE90 Message Type Code 13 Message Identifier Code: PU2 Narrative Message Text: PGA DATA MSNG FOR HTS - NO ACTION REQ

#### Tentative Mandatory Date: TBD


- Filers using ACE must enter FWS data (or disclaim)
- Filers will <u>always</u> have the option to file via eDecs




# Status of FWS ACE Filings

- Over 10,000 ACE entries processed
- Over 120 separate filers
- Current filings
  - 60% EDS
  - 40% LDS
